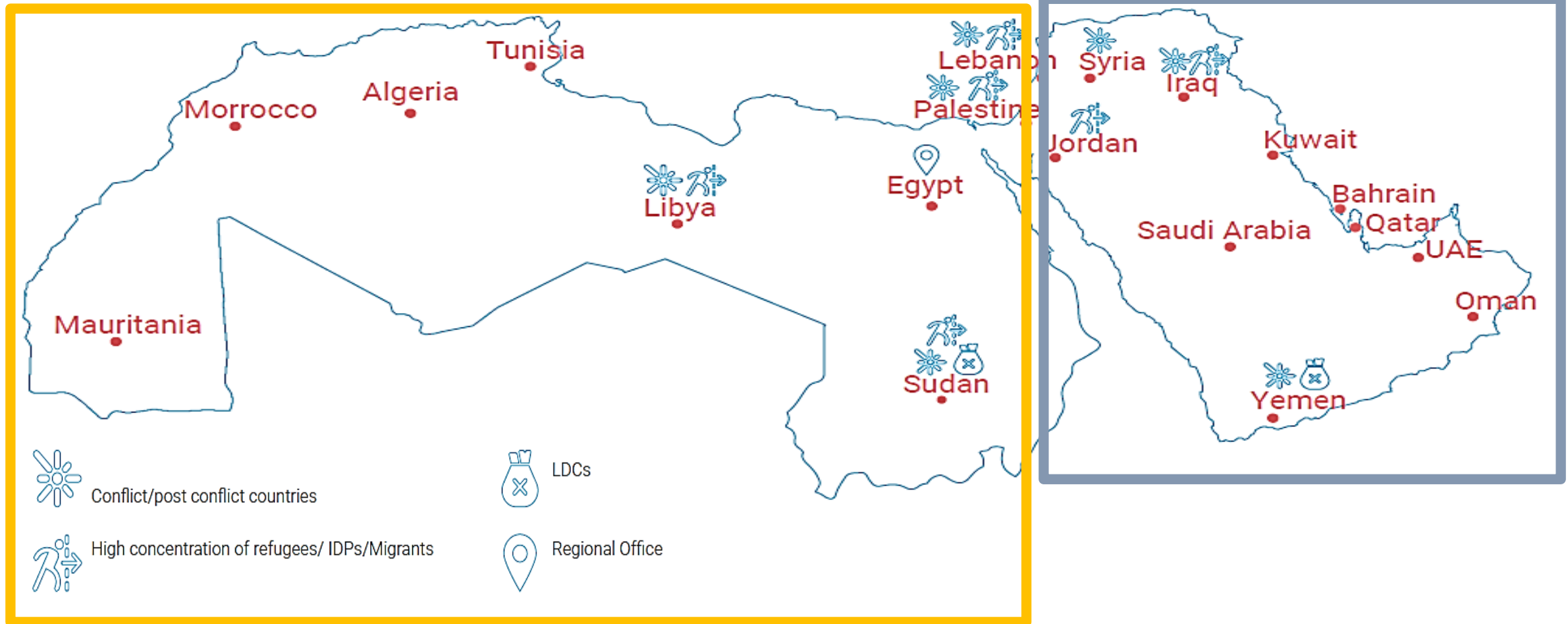

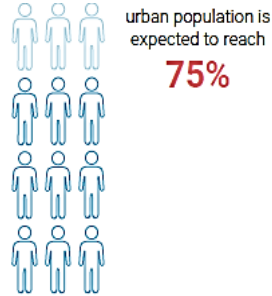
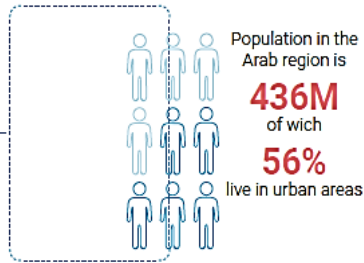
# ROAS Presence – General Facts

UN-Habitat Regional Office for Arab States (ROAS) has a mandate to provide policy advice, technical cooperation and capacity building for eighteen countries across the Arab region: Algeria, Bahrain, Egypt, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Palestine, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Syria, Sudan, Tunisia, the United Arab Emirates, and Yemen. ROAS currently has operational projects in **16 countries** and **14 operating** country offices/programmes



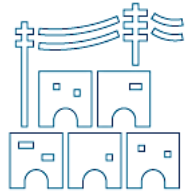
# ROAS Presence – General Facts

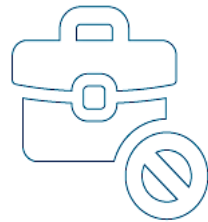
Average of **18%** of the population live below each country's national poverty line with around **38.2 Million** living in acute poverty

**17 Million** to lose their jobs as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.



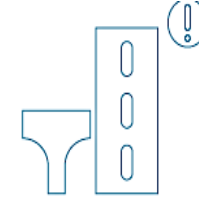
**14.3 Million** people are unemployed, ILO estimates. The region has the highest unemployment rates in the world for women



Conflicts in Yemen, Libya, Palestine, Iraq, Sudan and Syria have led to **waves of displacement**



**58%** of the **world refugees** originated from the region



Estimated cost of **damage** and destruction of the physical infrastructure caused by the Syrian crisis: **USD 120 billion** (2018)



**Syrian crisis** has led to large-scale migration and displacement of over **5.6 Million refugees**

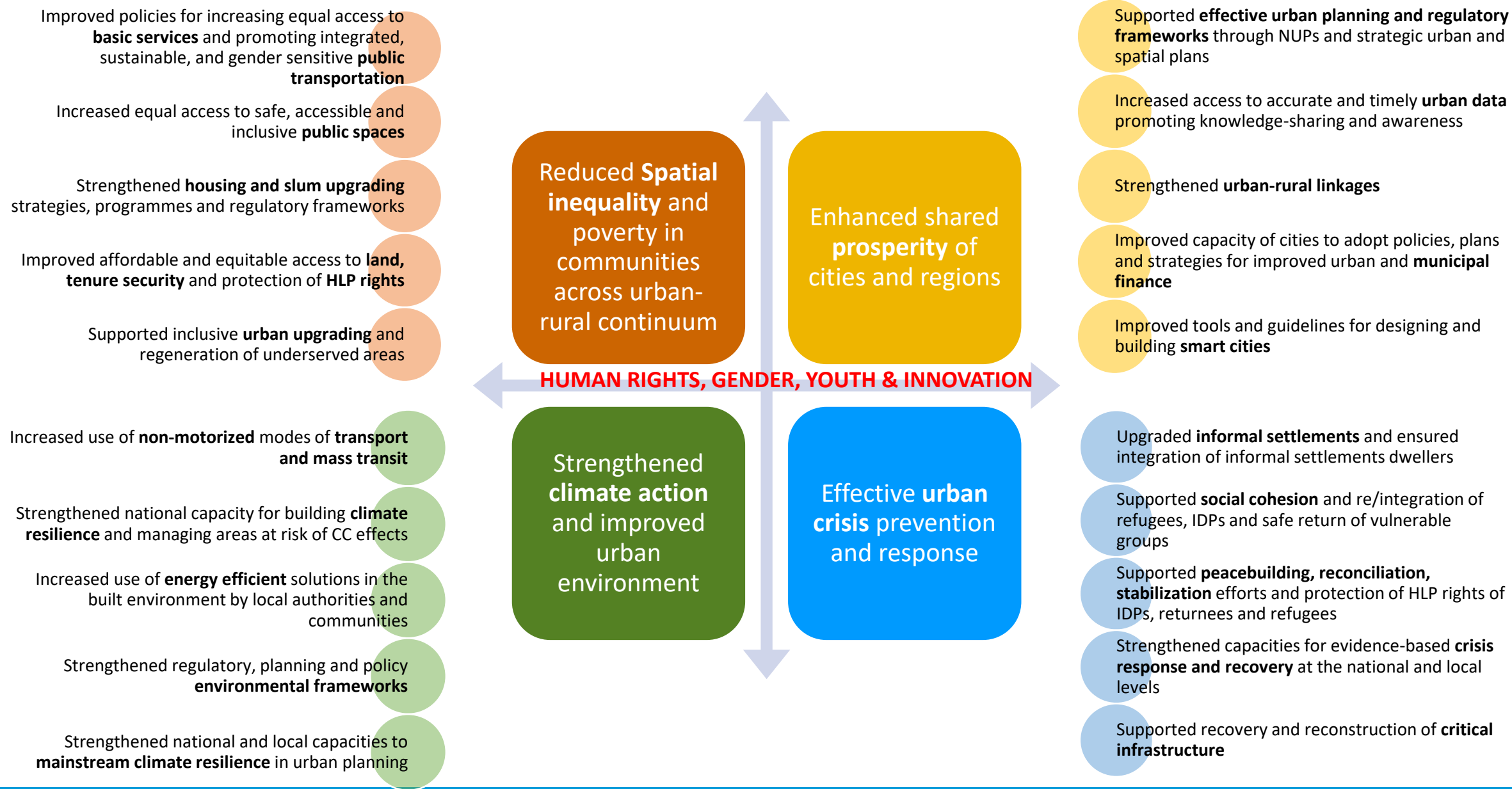


Arab region is the most **water scarce** region in the world with only **1.4%** of the world's renewable fresh water

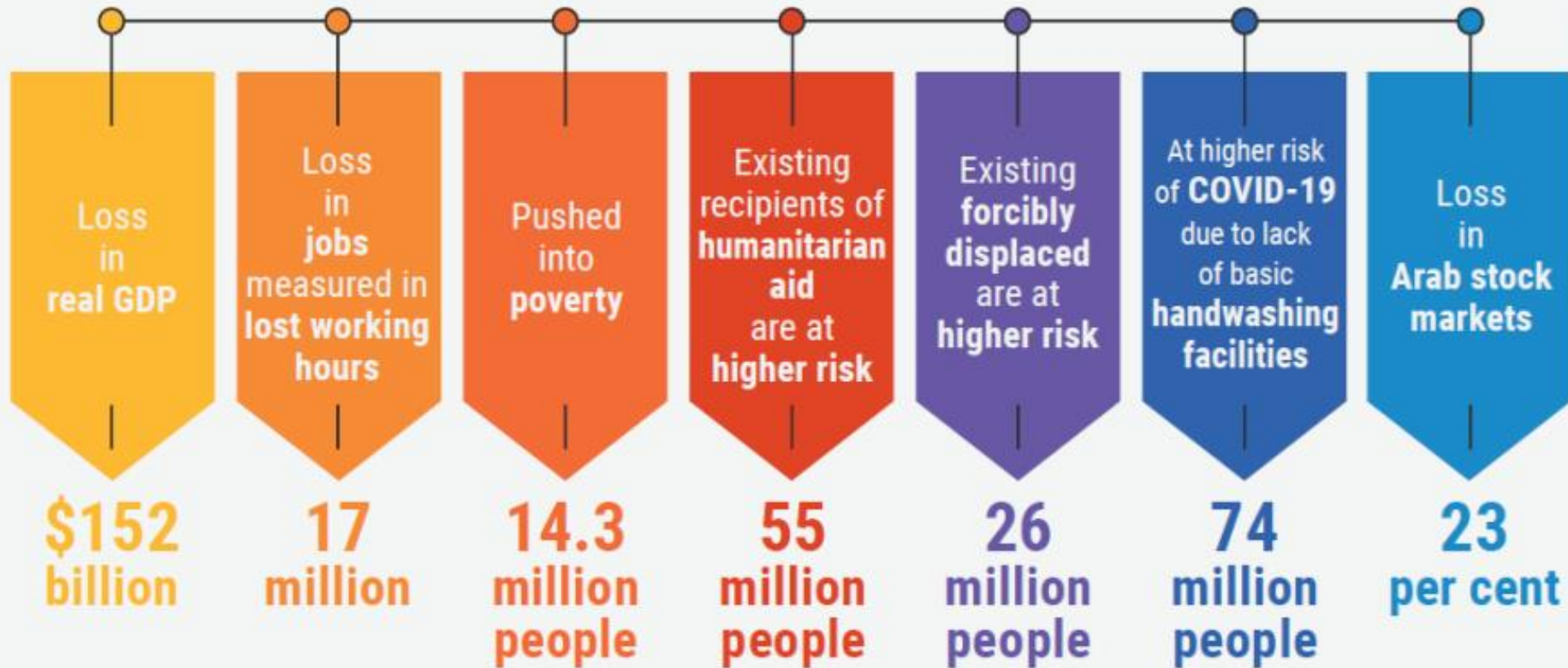

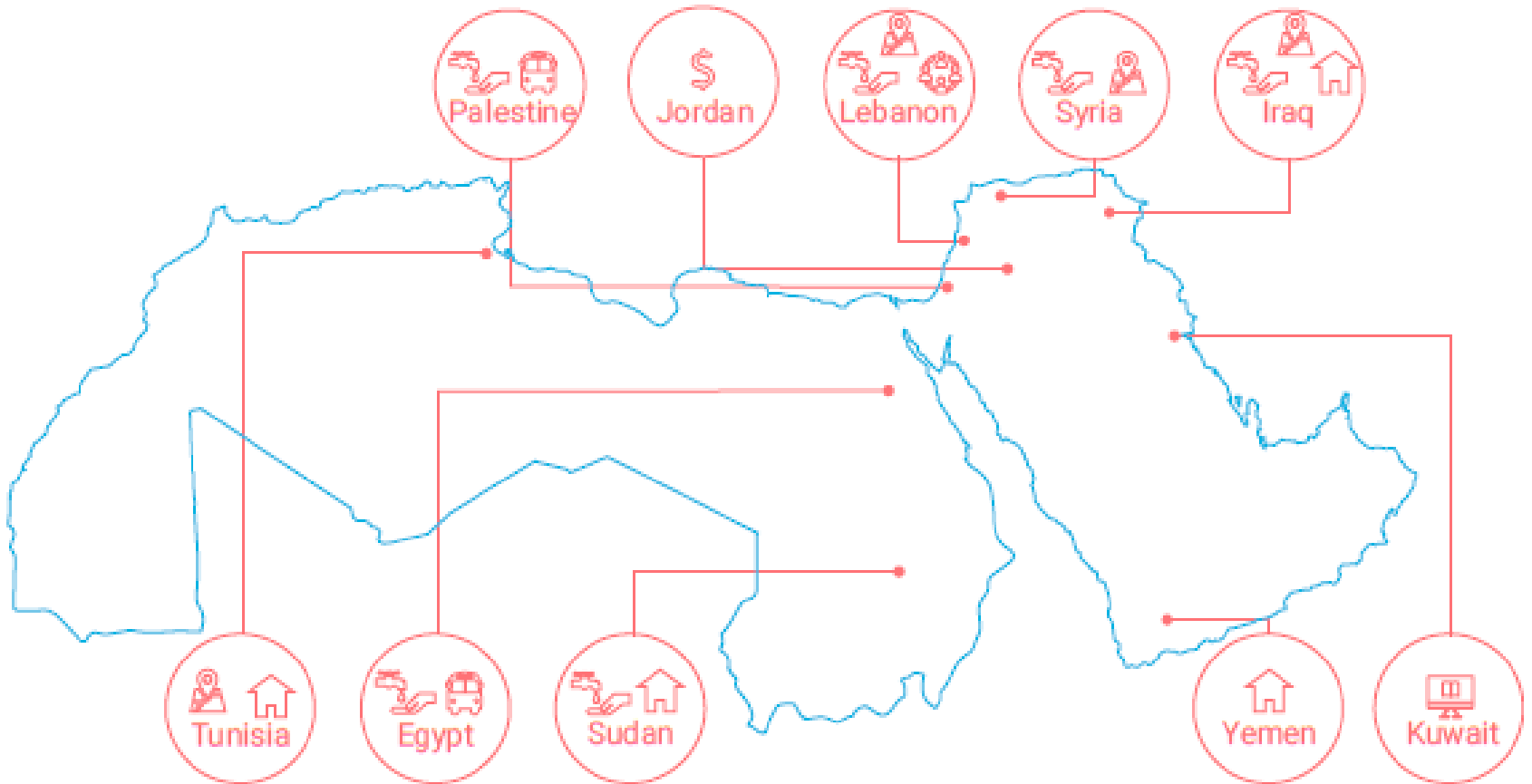
## ESTIMATED IMPACT OF COVID-19 PANDEMIC IN THE ARAB REGION
