





#### OUTCOME 4.3







## FINANCIAL CONSTRAINTS & IMPLICATIONS







Revenue stream for 2019: **USD 202 million** 

Only **USD 5 million** in core contributions

### Reliance on Earmarked Funding:

- Multilateralism at stake
- Inability to direct resources to places in need
- No representation work Staff moved onto Programme Support Cost

Total staff numbers: 303


