UN-Habitat has been approached to provide technical support to the Egyptian Government in addressing the development of Al-Alamein New City. Al Alamein is considered as a pilot intervention that promotes the New Urban Agenda and the City of the 21st Century. It falls within the activities of the ASUD project (Achieving Sustainable Urban Development), launched by UN-Habitat’s Executive Director in 2013. Al-Alamein New City represents a new approach for planning new cities in Egypt distinct from previous generations. It should function as a new model for city development acting as a development catalyzer in the North Coast Region.

**Resilient City** is one that has the capacity to absorb future.

**Sustainable Economic Development** by integrating environmental and social objectives together with the economic one in a balance, supportive and complementary manner.

**Ecological Limits of The City** represents the limit to the amount of resources, productive land and sea area required to support economic and municipal activities, and to assimilate generated waste that the City cannot exceed.
